



# BJÖRKSJÖN, 30 km

Difficulty level: **Blue**

Start and Finish: Church in Hjulsjö

Altitude: 105 m

Lots of steep slopes and slightly more difficult paths. Ride across the football field and follow the gravel road for about 3.5 km. Turn left onto the path, then out onto the gravel road again towards **Björksjön**, where there is a fine view from the village. Ride through the village and turn right onto a smaller road after 6 km. At the end of the road, carry straight on on the tractor track where you can enjoy the beautiful natural surroundings.

Turn left towards **Havsjön**, the highest village on the trail, where the artist known as Björnjägaren ("the Bear Hunter") once lived. Turn left towards **Björksjön** and right after 13 km on a path towards **Bysjötorp**. This section is a little tricky, but quite possible to ride. Then follow the road left towards **Bredsjö** where you pass **Bredsjö Manors**. Ride through the village out on the old railway towards **Hjulsjö**. Don't miss the beautiful views over the **Lilla Bredsjön lake**.

After the old railway, you take the left out onto the tarmac road towards **Bredsjö**, about 200 m to the right and then follow the gravel road towards **Hjulsjö**. Turn left on the large road and towards **Hjulsjö**.
